

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP,
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
RESOLUTION NO. 2010-43**

WHEREAS, the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors passed Resolution No. 2010-31 permitting deer hunting by licensed hunting groups on Township owned open space properties and issuing a license to hunt on Township open space properties to the Franklin Township Deer Management Association subject to certain requirements set forth in the Resolution.

WHEREAS, at its meeting on November 17, 2010, the Board of Supervisors voted to waive the requirement in Resolution No. 2010-31 for archery hunters to take and pass the Pennsylvania Game Commission Bow Hunter Education Course before hunting on Township open space properties. The Board's motion was subject to a two week review period for individual Board Members to investigate whether the test could be taken or whether an alternative test was available. The Board's motion passed unanimously.

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the two week period spelled out in the Board's November 17, 2010 motion, Supervisor Paul Overton was the only supervisor to rescind his vote for the measure.


NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township HEREBY RESOLVES to waive the requirement in Resolution No. 2010-31 for archery hunters to take and pass the Pennsylvania Game Commission Bow Hunter Education Course before hunting on Township open space properties.

The Board of Supervisors of Franklin Township further RESOLVES that in lieu of taking the Pennsylvania Game Commission Bow Hunter Education Course, all hunters on Township open space properties must take and pass a hunting proficiency test administered by the Natural Lands Trust on behalf of the Township. For the 2010 hunting season this proficiency test shall replace the requirement for hunters to pass: a) a proficiency test administered by the Association, and b) the Pennsylvania Game Commission Bow Hunter Education Course. Only members of the Franklin Township Deer Management Association who have passed the proficiency test administered by the Township shall be authorized to hunt on Township open space properties.

All other requirements set forth in Resolution No. 2010-31 shall remain in full force and effect.
