

FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP  
PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing at 7:30 PM on June 17, 2009 at the Franklin Township Municipal Office, 20 Municipal Lane, Kemblesville, PA 19347 to inform the public and obtain public comment on the Franklin Township Trail Feasibility Study and Master Plan, which will be considered for adoption, and may be adopted by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors as an amendment to the Franklin Township Comprehensive Plan.

The text of Trail Feasibility Study and Master Plan contains an Executive Summary; outlines potential demand analysis and benefits of a trail system in the Township; outlines trail opportunities and feasibility determinations for trails on lands and roads in the Township with recommended locations, alignments and construction; sets forth trail development cost estimates and potential funding for priority and non-priority trails; and provides population characteristics and recreation needs within the Township. The Plan contains Tables concerning costs of priority trails, roads with trail opportunities, recommended trail segments, trailhead facilities, project phasing, and construction cost estimates for the East, West and Middle Branch White Clay Creek, Appleton Road, Foote Farm, Guernsey Road, Park Links, Pennock Bridge Road and West Trails along with annual trail maintenance costs estimates. In addition the Plan contains maps concerning land and roads with trail opportunities, trail recommendations, and maps of the East, West and Middle Branch White Clay Creek, Appleton Road, Foote Farm, Guernsey Road, Park Links, Pennock Bridge Road and West Trails.

A full text copy of the Resolution and Trail Feasibility Study and Master Plan is available for public examination without charge or may be obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof at the Township Offices located at 20 Municipal Lane, Kemblesville, PA 19347 during regular business hours Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M., except holidays.
