Planning & Zoning:

a. The PC reviewed Township Engineers Eisenbrown' s review letter for 1691 New London Road, Land Development Plan, Dated August 2, 2021. The plan was prepared by the PELSA Company, drawing number P-4040. Chip Hazel of PELSA provided an update on the progress for 1691 New London Road, responding to Engineer Eisenbrown' s comments that were based upon Chapter 22, [Subdivision and Land Development]. Chapter 25, [Transportation Impact Fee], and other related sections. Mr. Hazel has agreed to the requirements and requested a waver for the one item listed below. In addition, the need for sidewalks may be required later. Mr. Heckrotte is still waiting on PennDOT's review of his highway occupancy permit.

<u>Section 22-710.</u> Sidewalks may be required by the Board of Supervisors. Mr. Heckrotte has agreed to support this initiative when the Township so requests.

<u>Waver/Requests:</u> Waver for the Preliminary-Final approval. Mr. Nuri will move forward requesting a waver for the Preliminary-Final Plan.
