The Plan is intended to guide future development of the Township based on recent information on existing and projected population and other conditions, mapping; plan recommendations for natural resources and the environment; parks and recreation; historic preservation; connectivity; community services and facilities; commercial and economic development; future land use; and the means by which they will be implemented.

A copy of the full text of the proposed Plan is available for public examination without charge on the Township website or may be obtained for a charge not greater than the cost of copying at the Franklin Township Municipal Office during regular business hours Monday through Thursday, 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M., except holidays. An opportunity will be afforded to all interested persons in attendance at the meeting to address the Planning Commission in the matter of the proposed Plan.
