Comp Plan Priority Subject Areas chapter – Roads & other Community Infrastructure

This chapter was reviewed by the CPTF at the August meeting. However, a Comp Plan Task Force member had specific input/comments on this chapter and there was not enough time to do so at the August meeting. This, they will be discussed at this meeting instead, briefly, as the CPTF need to complete review of the Future Land Use chapter as well as discuss next steps in the Comp Plan process.

Comp Plan Priority Subject Areas chapter – Future Land Use

We will discuss the draft Future Land Use priority subject area chapter that is based on community input. Then we will discuss implementation priorities for recommendations for this chapter. Note that this chapter includes future land use recommendations for the Agricultural Retention chapter and the Kemblesville Village Enhancement chapter for ease of review and comparison by the CPTF. However, after CPTF review, both sets of land use recommendations swill be placed back in their respective chapters. (As background information when reviewing these chapters, with a subject area Comp Plan format, the chapter revolves around recommendations. The chapter provides basic background information plus a goal, but is focused on recommendations, actions, and explanations and supportive information about each action. See Table of Contents outline you had received prior for reference.)

Next Steps in Comp Plan Process

Future Land Use is the last priority subject chapter for 1st draft review. Next, CCPC will produce the full draft of the Comp Plan and the CPTF will then meet to review the full draft. This full draft review is planned to occur at November and December CPTF meetings.
